

COMMUNITY SUPPORTED AGRICULTURE AT WESTWIND FARM....

Quite a few farms offer Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) programs. They generally involve paying during the winter months for a season of produce to be picked up during the summer and fall. Every farm is unique in their offerings.

At Westwind, we offer fresh and healthy vegetables, as well as bread, eggs, flour, baking mixes, and eggs, all of which are produced here at the Farm. You can customize your share to include all of the Farm's Harvest, or only certain ones that suit your needs. You also choose whether you'd like a large (every week pick up) or small (every other week pick up) sized share. We have an annual CSA Luncheon Meeting in January each year to get feedback from last year and /or questions, requests, etc., for the upcoming season. Sign up runs from January through the end of March, after which payments are non-refundable. Final payments are due by mid-May. Sign up may be extended until early June if need be.

Pick up times for the CSA (and for other on farm orders) are Fridays 4-8 pm and Saturdays, 10-3. The rest of the days we are out gardening, preparing the foods for your shares, or if it's a Sunday, we're on family day — no business is transacted.
