

WESTWIND FARM RULES

Our Farm is a beautiful place to discover Nature, re-discover lost arts and skills, to learn the tools of self-sufficiency, and to find new, old friends. To ensure that everyone gets the most out of their experience, we all need to follow a few rules of farm life.

They are:

1. All Classes and Events are guided. **Staying with the group is important for your safety.** Farm equipment and animals in uncontrolled situations can be hazardous.
2. If it says “Don’t Touch”, “Keep Out”, etc., **be sure to obey the signs.** Westwind Farm, LLC will not be held liable for those who suffer the consequences of not following directions.
3. Be sure to let us know if anyone has allergies to bee stings, poison ivy, molds, or any other physical condition. *We will do our best to accommodate everyone.* We have a first aid kit that we bring with us on the wagon, but we are not medically equipped for serious medical emergencies. It is the guest’s responsibility to bring any of their own medical needs, such as asthma inhalers, insulin, etc. **All guests come at their own risk when they participate in any Farm Class or Event.**
4. **Dogs are not allowed.** We have cats and other animals that may be spooked, and some guests are uncomfortable with dogs. Our dogs at Westwind are accustomed to our animals, and may be present. If any guest lets us know that they are uncomfortable with them, we keep them inside. Cars are not good places to leave dogs for several hours, so please leave them at home.
5. **Inappropriate behavior**, such as bullying towards others, abuse of animals, and any disruptions that interrupt the flow of class or event **will not be tolerated.** Such people will be asked to leave, and will not receive a refund, all or in part, for their class fee.
