Lots of cool Nature Projects, including felting wool, making their own Nature Guide, nature art projects, planting seeds & making scarecrows, taking wagon rides thru the Farm and daily gatherings from the garden to make their own fun culinary creations await our Day Campers. We also discuss the whys and hows of gardens and all of Nature that work together to create sustainable systems. We encourage kids to attend all three sessions, as projects overlap. If your schedule only permits one or two sessions, we'll be sure your child gets the most out of their experience at Westwind Farm. In addition to food the children make & take home, an organic lunch is provided, as well .

Spring May 21 & 22, 10–5 Sat. & 12–5 Sun

Summer July 16 & 17, 10–5 Sat. & 12–5 Sun

Fall Sept. 17 & 18, 10–5 Sat. & 12–5 Sun
